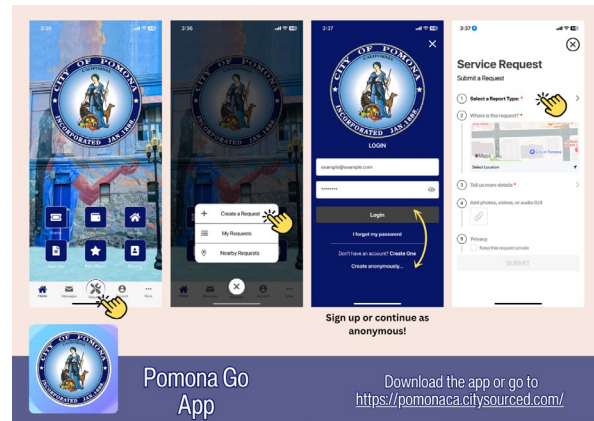

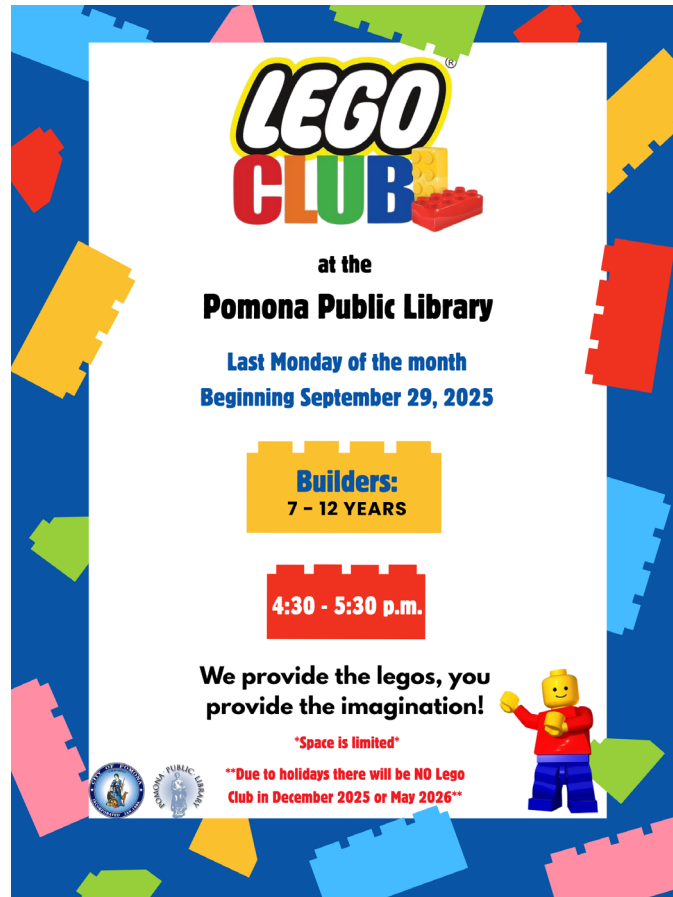

## **PUBLIC WORKS**

### **PARKING SCAM WARNING - VEHICLE PARKING DISTRICT (VPD) PARKING LOTS**

Please be advised that there are **no parking attendants** on duty in the City's VPD parking lots, **except for valet services in Lot 12**, All parking payments must be made at the kiosk or by using one of the VPD payment Apps only – no one should ask you for cash or card payment directly. If any individual approaches you claiming to be a parking attendant, do NOT give them money. If possible, report the incident to the Police or to the City immediately.

As of *January 15, 2025*, parking payment kiosks no longer accept cash payments for daily parking in all VPD parking lots. Daily parking purchases (payments) may be made via credit card or debit at the payment kiosks and through the Flowbird Mobile Parking application. By scanning the QR code at the machine, you can access the Flowbird mobile parking application. The application can also be downloaded from the Apple App Store or from Google Play for Android powered devices. You will be directed to input a parking stall number and a parking lot number. Once you have made your payment, it will be posted in the system. You are not required to display your receipt. All other restrictions and time limits will continue as posted.

Please remember: **Pay only at the kiosk or through the mobile app** to ensure your payment is properly processed. Your safety and security remain our highest priorities. We appreciate your attention and cooperation.

## VPD LOT 10 - TEMPORARY CLOSURE MONDAY, OCTOBER 13<sup>TH</sup>

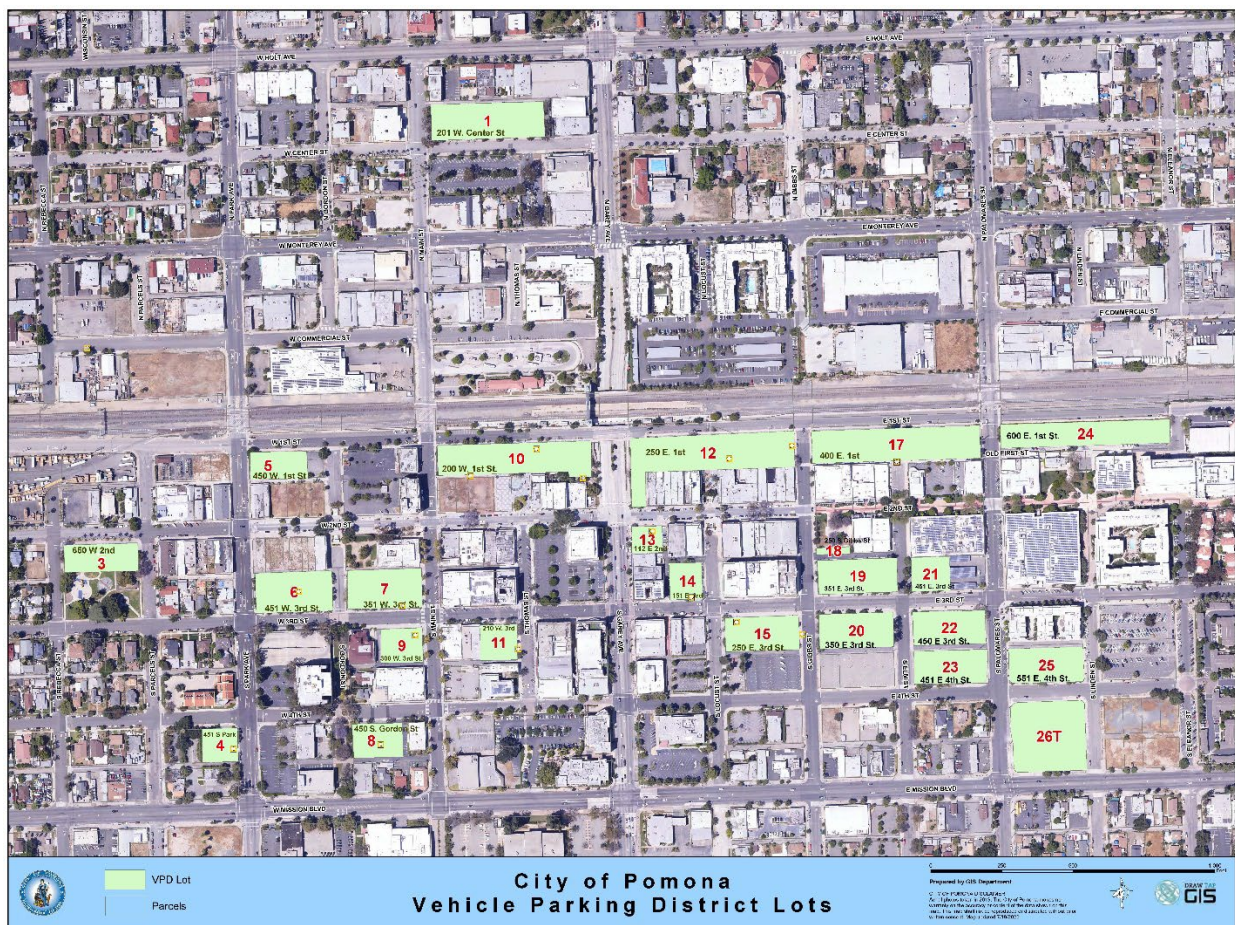
