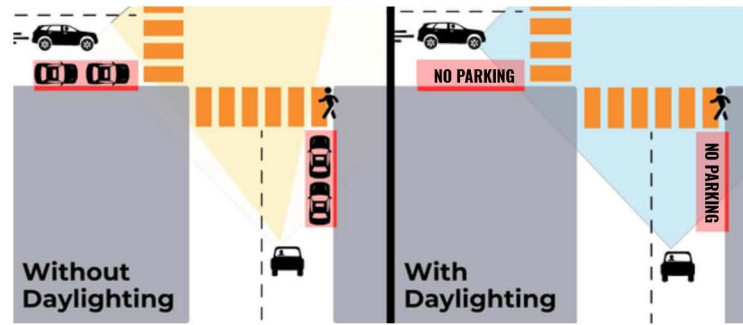

WHAT IS AB 413?

AB 413, KNOWN AS THE DAYLIGHTING BILL, PROHIBITS PARKING WITHIN 20 FEET OF ANY MARKED OR UNMARKED CROSSWALK, OR 15 FEET WHERE A CURB EXTENSION EXISTS



WHY IS THIS IMPORTANT?

- REDUCES TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS AND PEDESTRIAN INJURIES
- IMPROVES VISIBILITY FOR ALL ROAD USERS
- ADDRESSES HIGH PEDESTRIAN FATALITY RATES IN CALIFORNIA



WHAT IS DAYLIGHTING?

DAYLIGHTING IMPROVES VISIBILITY AT INTERSECTIONS BY REMOVING PARKED VEHICLES NEAR CROSSWALKS, ENHANCING SAFETY FOR PEDESTRIANS AND DRIVERS



WHAT DRIVERS NEED TO KNOW

- NO PARKING WITHIN 20 FEET OF ANY CROSSWALK
- APPLIES TO ALL INTERSECTIONS, EVEN WITHOUT SIGNS OR RED CURBS
- AFFECTS BOTH PRIVATE AND COMMERCIAL VEHICLES
